#### TO BE ELIGIBLE, THE APPLICANT MUST:

- 1. Be pursuing a college degree at an accredited academic institution.
- 2. Have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5.

#### A COMPLETE APPLICATION MUST INCLUDE:

- 1. A completed and signed application.
- 2. A one page essay of no less than 250 and no more than 500 words that articulate your answer to the following questions: How are you inspired by Olivia and the mission of the Olivia Constants Foundation, Inc.? What have you done to impact others positively? If awarded a scholarship, how will you give back to support the mission of the Olivia Constants Foundation, Inc. in the future?
- 3. Two letters of recommendation written by teachers/professors, coaches or community service representatives who are familiar with you and your character.
- 4. Proof of enrollment from the college/university you will be or are attending.
- 5. A copy of your most recent official high school or college transcript.

Scholarship recipients will be notified of the Board's decision by June 30<sup>th</sup>. Scholarship recipients may be requested to take a picture with Board members and information from the application may be used for any purpose deemed necessary to promote the Olivia Constants Foundation, Inc.
